### PUBLIC NOTICE


Housing Works will open the Mainstream Housing Choice Voucher waiting list on **Monday, February 4<sup>th</sup>, 2013** through **Friday, February 8<sup>th</sup>, 2013**. Applicants are asked to apply for the waitlist online at [www.oregonhousingworks.org](http://www.oregonhousingworks.org). This is a first-come, first-served waitlist. The online application will open from 1:00 pm on the 4<sup>th</sup> of February until 5:00 pm on the 8<sup>th</sup> of February. Central Oregon Community Service Agencies may assist their clients in the filling out the online application form. Upon request, Housing Works staff will provide technical assistance for clients filling out the online application. The application must be complete in order to be accepted by the online wait list system for processing.

Families may request paper application as a reasonable accommodation. Reasonable accommodations must be in writing and may be granted should an individual have barriers to completing the online application.

The Mainstream Housing Choice Voucher Program provides rental assistance for low-income households that meet income eligibility requirements. Applicants must be a disabled head, co-head, or spouse of household and under 62 years of age. This is a first-come, first-served to be placed onto the waiting list. Should funding become available within a one year timeframe, applicants will be processed in the order their application was received. If selected, the applicant will be contacted by mail to proceed with the eligibility process. At the conclusion of one year, if funding has not been allocated, a new waiting list will be opened and previous applicants must reapply.
