Housing Works will open the waiting list for (8) three bedroom Project Based Voucher units located at Barnes Butte Vista, Prineville Oregon at **8:00 a.m. Monday June 20<sup>th</sup>, 2022 through 5:00 p.m. Thursday June 23<sup>rd</sup>, 2022**. Applicants must apply for the waiting list by submitting a completed pre-application in person at the Housing Works office located at 405 SW 6th St., Redmond Or 97756, drop box located in front of building, faxing to 541-923-6441 or via email to [stephanie@housing-works.org](mailto:stephanie@housing-works.org).

Housing Works has a local residency preference. Those applicants that reside in Crook, Deschutes or Jefferson Counties or whose household includes a family member who works, or has been notified that they are hired to work, in Crook, Deschutes or Jefferson Counties will be served before those residing outside this area. Additionally, this waitlist has two different preferences for individuals working with Saving Grace or the local VA office. For the 8 Project Based Voucher units, (3) have a preference for survivors of domestic violence working with Saving Grace, (2) have a preference for homeless veterans working with the local VA office, and (3) are designated for the general public.

**Income limits apply.** Please note that these units have an income limit at or below 30% of the area median income under the Low Income Housing Tax Credit Program. All applications taken during this time frame will be randomized by a computer and placed on the waiting list to give all applicants an equal chance.
