Housing Works is pleased to announce the re-opening of the Project Based Voucher Waiting List for (8) three-bedroom Project Based Voucher units located at Canyon Edge, Redmond OR at **8:00 a.m. on Monday November 4, 2024 through 5:00 p.m. Friday November 8, 2024.**

Applicants must apply for the waiting list by submitting a completed pre-application in person at either Housing Works office located at: 405 SW 6th St., Redmond OR 97756 or our Bend office: 2017 NE Full Moon Dr. Suite 100, Bend OR 97701. Pre-applications can also be placed in the drop box located in front of each building, faxing to 541-923-6441 or by email to [stephanie@housing-works.org](mailto:stephanie@housing-works.org).

**Income limits and occupancy standards apply** for all Project Based Voucher Units. The timing of your pre-application within the specified timeframe will not affect your placement on the waiting list. All pre-applications received during this period will undergo a randomized computer process, ensuring equitable placement on the waiting list and providing each applicant an equal chance of selection. Once each waitlist is exhausted, all pre-applications will be removed, requiring applicants who were not selected to reapply during the subsequent waitlist reopening.

**Canyon Edge in Redmond, OR:**

Eight – 3-bedroom Project Based Voucher units located at in Redmond, OR. This waitlist has a local residency preference. Priority will be given to applicants that reside in Crook, Deschutes or Jefferson Counties or whose household includes a family member who works or has been notified that they are hired to work, in Crook, Deschutes or Jefferson Counties. These applicants will be served before those residing outside this area. Additionally, these units have a preference for applicants with an income limit at or below 30% of the area median income under the Low-Income Housing Tax Credit Program.

For those requiring technical assistance during the application process, Housing Works will be available for support from 8:00 am PST to 5:00 pm PST Monday to Thursday (closed to public on Friday's) at 405 SW 6th St, Redmond, OR 97756.
